6 September - opening of VIIth Assembly by Dr. Benes  
(Czechoslovakia) - Election of President of Assembly  
M. Nintchich (Yugoslavia).

8 September - Assembly voting on admission to be sent to Germany -  
signed by League Secretary General Drummond. - Acceptance reply  
from the German Government signed by Stresemann - Arrival of  
German delegation to attend Assembly.

10 September - Herr Stresemann leaving his hotel, arriving at  
Assembly Hall and addressing meeting. - Address by M. Briand  
(France) - Assembly dispersing - Delegates leaving Assembly  
watched by crowds gathered outside building. Departures in  
the following order:
