EDUCATION:

Women literacy classes in Mali; elementary schools in Egypt,
Sudan (UNICEF) and Mozambique.

HEALTH

Primary health care in Mozambique (UNICEF); women's centres in
Cameroon (UNFPA/UNICEF/WFP); family planning in Yemen (UNFPA);
AIDS control programme in Madagascar (WHO); family planning is
encouraged through theatre in Ghana (UNFPA).

EMPLOYMENT

Women sell their goods in the market, Mali; men working in a
scrap metal recycling shop, Kenya (UNDP); satellite dishes are
installed, Cameroon (UNDP); cooperatives in Cote d'Ivoire (ILO);
grass roots sustainable project in Ghana (UNDP).

WATER AND FOOD SECURITY

Children pumping water in Liberia; digging wells in Mozambique
(UNICEF); irrigation systems in Somalia (WFP); cattle disease in
Tanzania (FAO); food assistance to Rwanda refugees (FAO).

PEACE-BUILDING AND GOOD GOVERNANCE

Children work for peace in Liberia and Angola; the UN assists in
establishing judicial systems in Somalia and Rwanda; trains the
police force in Somalia; free press in Ghana (UNESCO) and Rwanda
(European Community in cooperation with UNHCR); elections in
South Africa and Mozambique.
